## Progestins by androgenic effect:

- drospirenone, desogestrel = anti-androgenic (good for acne)
- levonorgestrel = most androgenic (bad for acne)

## Yaz & Yasmin (containing drospirenone)

- Health Canada review of studies showing increased RR of VTE that is 1.5-3x higher than other OCPs
- however AR still exceedingly low (e.g. for levonorgestrel containing OCPs risk of blood clot is 1 in 10,000/yr, so the estimated risk on Yaz or Yasmin is 1.5-3 in 10,000/yr)
- for context, risk of VTE in pregnancy is 1/1000 (appx 10x greater)
- should counsel pt about this ↑ RR but still ↓ AR as they may google their birth control and read about blood clots
